TUESDAY, JUNE 20th – OVERNIGHT AT TURNING STONE CASINO

Join us on a journey highlighting the natural beauty and the stunning coast lines of the islands of Cape Cod! We begin by traveling to the Finger Lake Region of New York and the Turning Stone Casino. Your evening is at leisure and dinner is included tonight.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 21st - WELCOME TO CAPE COD...

Today, we continue on east into Massachusetts, the “Bay State,” and the sandy shores of Cape Cod. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. You can walk pristine beaches, revel in the arts and culture, and reclaim childhood memories of seashells, sandcastles, and saltwater taffy. Our local guide for the trip will meet us at the Hyannis Harbor Hotel this afternoon at check in, where you will receive a complimentary print by a local artist.

THURSDAY, JUNE 22nd – PROVINCETOWN – YOUR CHOICE OF A WHALE WATCH!

Begin a full day of sightseeing, as a local guide shares with you, the history of the Cape as we travel along scenic ROUTE 6A, which is filled with wonderful examples of Cape Cod architecture. You will notice that the landscape dramatically changes as you approach Provincetown, which is at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Enjoy some free time to explore the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists/fishermen village so unique. This afternoon you can board an excursion vessel for an amazing experience of WHALE WATCHING, where you will travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment including birds that migrate here from all over the Atlantic, and fish which use these shallow waters to feed, this is the area where you may see Humpback, Minke, and Fin Whales going about their daily business. Or Choose To Stay On Dry Land For anyone not wishing to go on a whale watch, admission is included on a Dune Tour. Ride along the shorelines of the protected lands of Cape Cod National Seashore. Your guide will point out the “dune shacks” where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art.

FRIDAY, JUNE 23rd – NANTUCKET ISLAND

Our morning Hy-Line Ferry excursion brings you to the stunning island of Nantucket, the smallest island in the Cape, known for its whaling industry. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided bus tour of the island to include the charming Colonial-Style houses and imposing mansions that reflect the prosperity of Nantucket’s whaling era. After the island tour, our guide will point out the restaurants, galleries, shops and museums that are all within walking distance to the dock. Midafternoon, our tour takes us back to Hyannis where our driving tour will continue featuring the Kennedy Family Compound, St Francis Xavier Church, and the John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum. Your evening is at leisure, to explore Hyannis; our hotel is located just 2 blocks from the Main Street, where everything is located.

SATURDAY, JUNE 24th – MARTHA’S VINEYARD ISLAND

This morning, ferry to Martha’s Vineyard, a longtime New England summer colony; it encompasses harbor towns, lighthouses, sandy beaches and farmland. Our tour of the vineyard features Oak Bluffs with its Victorian “gingerbread” architecture. Spend some time in Edgartown, once an important shipping and whaling center. Check out the enticing village stores, take a walk along ocean and enjoy the salt breeze, and admire the elegant homes along the tree-lined streets during your time here. A Lobster dinner is included this evening alternate entrees will be available.

MONDAY, JUNE 25TH - PIRATES & LOST TREASURES & SALEM CROSS INN

Enjoy a leisure breakfast with your last views of the harbor, before our mid-morning departure for our visit to the Whydah Pirate Museum. The Whydah was a fully rigged galley ship that was built by the British. During one of its voyages in 1717, it was captured by the famed pirate Samuel "Black Sam" Bellamy. During an infamous storm off the coast of Cape Cod the Whydah sank, laying its treasure just 500 feet off the shore for over 250 years. Now you can touch and see the world's only authenticated pirate treasure. After lunch, we continue on this afternoon to West Brookfield and the Salem Cross Inn. Let the Farewell Fireplace Feast begin, one of our many dining events that provide an authentic colonial experience. The Inn captures the history and culture of 1700's America.

TUESDAY, JUNE 26TH - NORMAN ROCKWELL MUSEUM, STOCKBRIDGE, MA

A special excursion is planned for you this morning at the Norman Rockwell Museum in Stockbridge. A museum guide, will join us, for an in-depth view of his life on a tour to include; some of Norman Rockwell's greatest works, his Studio, the Peter Rockwell sculpture walk, and the exterior of the Linwood mansion. Your guide will give you an overview of the site and share its rich and colorful history. Lunch is included at the museum. Our overnight hotel is in Auburn, New York.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27TH - JOURNEY HOME – Hotel check out and depart for home with sand in your shoes, seashells in your pocket and many fond memories of your Cape Cod tour. **Meals: (B)**
