## ***Friday September 7***

## ***Saturday September 8***

This morning you will have time to explore the world-renowned Smithsonian, the world's largest museum complex and research organization. Some of the more famous exhibitions include the Hope Diamond, gowns of the First Ladies, Lindbergh's Spirit of St. Louis and the command module from Apollo 11. or you might opt to explore on your own a museum of your choice. This afternoon we will visit Lafayette Park and a firsthand view of the White House, Jefferson, FDR and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Memorials. 6 :15pm Dinner is included at the Royal Restaurant in Alexandria, VA. Following dinner we will stop by the U.S. Air force Memorial for a night time view of our nation's capital. The rest of the evening is at leisure.

## ***Sunday September 9***

This morning a step on guide will join, as you see history in the making on your panoramic tour of our nation's capital to include Embassy Row, the National Cathedral and White House Visitor's Center. Your tour will also include a visit to the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center. An extension of the Capitol itself, the Visitor Center welcomes you to the seat of American Government in a facility neatly hidden underground next to the Capitol itself. Lunch is on your own. After lunch we will visit the following memorials, Vietnam. 6:00pm Dinner is included tonight , followed by a visit to the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts

## ***Monday September 10***

Start the day with a visit to Arlington National Cemetery - the final resting place of many of our national heroes. You will enjoy a narrated tour mobile ride that will make stops throughout the cemetery. View the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, followed by a stop at the United States Marine Corp Memorial. A Lunch and rest stops will be made on our way home.
